**Order Rescinding Court Order on Prohibition of Certain Fireworks**

**BE IT REMEMBERED**, that on the 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2018 the DeWitt County Commissioners Court adopted Court Order No. 2018-034, an Order Prohibiting Certain Fireworks in unincorporated areas of DeWitt County, due to extant circumstances that warranted the imposition of said order; and


**WHEREAS**, the conditions that warranted the adoption of Said Order have dissipated significantly or no longer exist in the County at this time; and

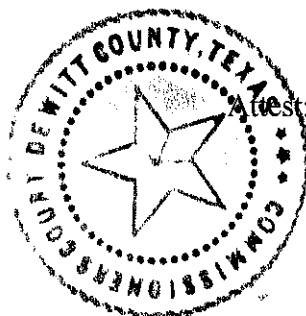
**WHEREAS**, during an open meeting of the Commissioner's Court held on June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018, the Commissioners Court of DeWitt County deliberated on whether to continue the ban of certain aerial fireworks;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED AND DECREED:**

1. That the Keech Byram Drought Index has fallen below the threshold that dictates the existence of drought conditions.
2. That the current prohibition of certain fireworks is no longer warranted.
3. That Commissioners Court Order No. 2018-034 rescinds the aforementioned Court Order immediately upon execution.
