


# Eagle Ford Shale

- Eagle Ford Shale continues to be a game changer for DeWitt County
- 125 RRC well permits in 2010
- 515 RRC well permits issued in 2013
- 363 wells completed (during last Texas FY)
- 500 permits are likely in 2014

# Development continues




#### Tax Base Comparison: Mineral Values



- \$90 of every \$100 in property taxes to be paid by oil and gas interests based on 2014 tax roll
- \$1.92 of every \$100 will be collected from the Over 65 and Disabled homesteads


### Typical Decline Curve of Shale Wells
