# ORDINANCE NO. 12-19-20 CITY OF YORKTOWN, TEXAS

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AND ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION FOR CITY OFFICERS TO BE HELD ON MAY 2, 2020 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE COUNCILMEMBERS.

## Section I.

A general election is hereby ordered to be held on May 2<sup>ND</sup>, 2020 for the purpose of electing three (3) Councilmen bers for the City of Yorktown, Texas. All voting conducted within this election shall be pursuant to the cumulative voting style. An Election Order, attached as Exhibit "A" is incorporated by reference herein, and is hereby adopted and ordered.

### Section II.

A candidate's application for a place on ballot for the general election must be filed by 5:00 p.m. on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The earliest for a candidate to file an application for a place on the ballot in person will be January 15, 2020 at 8:00 AM.

### Section III.

Early voting by persor al appearance will be conducted each weekday at Yorktown City Hall, Yorktown between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. beginning on April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and ending on April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020. In ad lition, two (2) twelve (12) hour days of early voting will be conducted on Monday April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and Tuesday April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

### Section IV.

The City Council here by appoints the DeWitt County Elections Administrator as the election officer for the sole purpose of conducting the election, early voting related thereto, tabulation of votes and the custody of any records from such election. This appointment includes services as the Early Voting Clerk for the Election, including for the receipt of applications and ballots for early voting by mail

The rate of pay for each election judge and clerk shall be \$10.00 per hour. In addition, the presiding judge responsible for delivering the ballots and other election materials and records to the return center shall be paid \$25 00 for such delivery.

Applications for ballot by mail must be received no later than the close of business on April 20th 2020.
