the requirements of the Texas Election Code and other law. The City Secretary is directed to publish notice of the election in the City's official newspaper. The notice shall be published the same day in each two successive weeks, with the first publication occurring before the tenth (10th) day before the clate of the election. To the extent applicable, the City Secretary shall also provide public notice of the election in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

Section 9. Severability: Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this Ordinance be adjusted or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance in whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional.

Section 10. Repealer: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances or parts of ordinances governing or regulating the same subject matter as that covered herein; provided, however, that all prior ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed to the extent that such inconsistency is apparent. This Ordinance shall not be construed to require or allow any act which is prohibited by any other Ordinance.

Section 11. Authorization to Execute: The Mayor is authorized to execute and the City Secretary is authorized to attest this Ordinance on behalf of the City Council; and the Mayor is authorized to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.

Section 12. Ef ective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication as may be required by law.

Section 13. Proper Notice and Meeting. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
