MINUTES OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF DE WITT COUNTY, TEXAS REGULAR MEETING – DECEMBER 13, 2021

DeWitt County Commissioners Court met in regular session December 13, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the County Courtroom at the DeWitt County Courthouse in Cuero, Texas, with the following members present:

County Judge Daryl L. Fowler Commissioner Curtis G. Afflerbach, Precinct No. 1 Commissioner James B. Pilchiek Sr., Precinct No. 2 Commissioner James Kaiser, Precinct No. 3 (arrived late) Commissioner Richard Randle, Precinct No. 4

Call to Order; Pledge of Allegiance & Invocation

Judge Fowler called the meeting to order and led everyone in the pledge of allegiance. Mr. Afflerbach gave the invocation.

New Business:

Public Hearing (No. 1)

Public hearing held in order to provide opportunity for public comments on establishing a 45 MPH speed limit on Garrett Road in Commissioner Precinct No. 2. No one was present to speak either for or against establishing the speed limit.

Close Public Hearing (No. 2)

Judge Fowler closed the public hearing.

Rule on Public Hearing (No. 3)

MOTION: Mr. Pilchiek made a motion to establish a 45 MPH speed limit on Garrett Road in Commissioner Precinct No. 2 to be effective when the signs go up. Mr. Kaiser seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Resolution Adopting Allocation Methods in Opioid Settlement (No. 4)

MOTION: Mr. Randle made a motion to adopt and approve the Janssen Texas Statewide Opioid Settlement Agreement and Settlement Term Sheet, Resolution Number 2021-071. Mr. Pilchiek seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Request from Constable Hobbs for Handheld Radio (No. 6)

MOTION: Mr. Kaiser made a motion to authorize Constable Pct. 2 Jefferson Hobbs to replace an obsolete Motorola handheld radio with an Apex 4000 handheld radio, paid out of Justice Court Security Fund, for the amount of \$2,385.80. Mr. Pilchiek seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Appraisal District Board of Directors Candidate Nomination for 2022-2023 term (No. 13)

MOTION: Mr. Afflerbach made a motion to approve adoption of the resolution casting votes for nominees to the 2022-2023 DeWitt County Appraisal District board of directors with 1000 of our votes going to James Pilchiek and 469 of our votes going to Pat Elder. Mr. Randle seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 4-0 with Mr. Pilchiek abstaining. [Resolution Order Number 2021-072]

Sale of County Property (No. 6)

MOTION: Mr. Afflerbach made a motion to approve the sale of 1.344 acres of county property that is located in the John J. Tumlinson Survey, Abstract A-45 and located within the corporate limits of the City of Cuero, TX to Texas Luxury Custom Homes LLC, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 272.001(b) at a cost of \$13,709.00 and the county reserves the minerals. Mr. Randle seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Engineering Services Master Contract (No. 12)

MOTION: Mr. Randle made a motion to enter into the Master Contract for Engineering Services with Urban Engineering and allow the county judge to execute the contract. Mr. Afflerbach seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Addendum to Agreement for Consumer Reports for Employment Purposes (No. 11)

MOTION: Mr. Kaiser made a motion to approve the Addendum to the Agreement for Consumer Reports for Employment Purposes with Employment Screening Services, Inc. (ESS, Inc.), approval of Notice to Users of Consumer Reports: Obligations of Users under the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) and a Summary of Your Rights Under the Fair Credit Reporting Act. Mr. Pilchiek seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

TxDOT County Assistance Program (No. 14)

MOTION: Mr. Randle made a motion to receive the TxDOT County Assistance Program funding and FY2022 allocation amount of \$27,356.00; fill out the paperwork so that the county will receive the appropriated material and authorize the county judge to sign for that. Mr. Kaiser seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Annual Report of Eminent Domain Authority (No. 16)

MOTION: Mr. Kaiser made a motion to approve the current eminent domain authority of the DeWitt County Commissioners Court; authorize the electronic submission of the annual report to the Comptroller of Public Accounts required by Section D of the Texas Government Code Chapter 2206. Mr. Pilchiek seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Closed/Executive Session (No. 7 & 9)

MOTION: Mr. Kaiser made a motion to go into closed/executive session pursuant to Section 551.129 of the Texas Government Code (consultation with attorney) and authorize the judge to be the record keeper at 9:45 a.m. Mr. Pilchiek seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote 5-0.

Trammel as plaintiff against DeWitt County, Texas as defendant in the District Court of 135th Judicial District of DeWitt County relinquishing all rights and ownership of said property. Mr. Randle seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

Litigation to Recover Small Claim (No. 10)
