Properly Qualified Applicants to Purchase a Certified Copy of Birth or Death Certificate (within closed years):

Self, Father (when listed on the record; if not listed, has a court order stating he is the father). Mother, Grandfather (see notation for father), Grandmother (see notation for father), Sibling, Spouse, Legal Guardian (a copy of the legal guardianship papers is required as proof), Legal Representative (document from the qualified applicant needed), a Local, State, and Federal law enforcement or governmental agencies (by demostrating a direct or tangible interest in the record when the information in the record is necessary to implement a statutory provision or to protect a personal legal property right
