

#### **Section V.**

The location of the polling place for the May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 election shall be held at the Yorktown City Hall 102 West Main St., Yorktown, TX. The polling place shall be kept open from seven o'clock (7) a.m. until seven o'clock (7) p.m. on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 and due returns shall be made to the City Council showing the number of votes cast for each candidate for membership on the City Council.

#### **Section VI.**

The City Secretary is hereby ordered and directed to prepare and issue ballots for said elections and to mark same as "Official Ballot." Said ballots shall be printed in English and in Spanish for use in said elections. Said ballots shall be suitable for use with a paper ballot voting system and other appropriate voting systems as required by law, and shall otherwise conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code so as to permit the voters to vote for the candidate of their choice.

The City Secretary is further ordered and directed to obtain accessible voting systems from DeWitt County, in accordance with Section 122.031-122.039 and, Section 122.091 of the Texas Election Code.

#### **Section VII.**

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract for election services, if necessary, between the DeWitt County Clerk and the City of Yorktown for services or equipment to be provided on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020, and these services or equipment shall include, but not be limited to, those services or equipment specified in said contract.

#### **Section VIII.**

Notice of said elections shall be posted by the City Secretary and shall be distributed by: 1) publishing notice of the elections, in English and Spanish, at least once, not earlier than the 30<sup>th</sup> day nor later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day before election day, in a newspaper of general circulation in the said City; and 2) not later than the 21<sup>st</sup> day before election day, by posting notice of the elections, in English and Spanish, on the City's bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the Yorktown City Council.

#### **Section IX.**

The way and manner of holding said elections, the notice to be given therefore, the polling places, the personnel and the officers who are to hold same, and all details connected with the holding of the elections shall be provided for and arranged by the City Secretary. Any omission or irregularity in the notice of elections or in the publication or posting of the notice of elections, or in the signing of same, shall not in any way affect or invalidate such elections.
